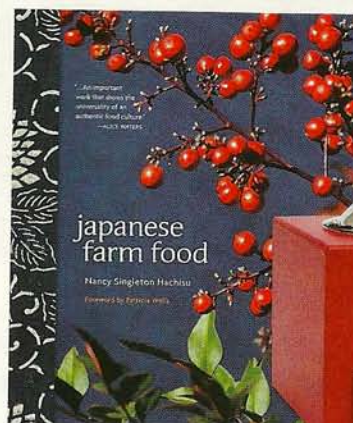
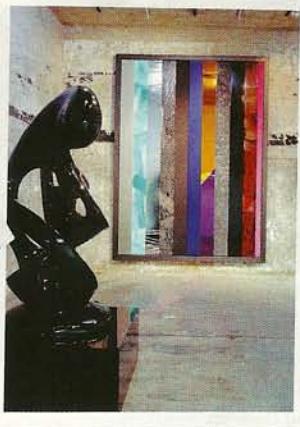
1 COCKTAIL UPGRADE
